EU REACH Directive Policy

European Union's REACH Directive 1999/45/EC regulates the import of chemical substances to the EU for the purpose of manufacturing articles, and articles that may release certain hazardous substances listed as "Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)" under "normal operating conditions".

SST's products do not release chemicals during the normal course of operations, and along with other international semiconductor manufacturers consider the REACH regulation not applicable to our industry. Therefore, SST is not required to "register" any compounds at this time.

To further ensure compliance, SST has surveyed all of our manufacturing partners to ensure none of the devices manufactured by the SST supply chain uses any of the current SVHC candidates, thus eliminating the need to declare usage of these chemical compounds.
